# AN UNEXPECTED VISIT



**D**on't look now, but God is talking with you.

How do you suppose this book came into your hands at this exact moment in time? Coincidence? Happenstance? Serendipity?

Really? During the very period in your life when you could really use some answers—you genuinely think you came across these words as a coincidence?

I know, I know, it sounds improbable, if not impossible, that God—if there even *is* a God—would decide to talk with you, *personally*, right now. Why would God want to do that?

Let's consider that question within a larger context. What if God is willing to talk to you all the time—and not only to you, but to all of us? Not just the Pope, or some saints and sages, or an occasional spiritual teacher here and there, or even an author now and then. Suppose God engages in direct communication with everyone who seeks a conversation. Or, to put it even more intriguingly, what if God is communicating with all of us all the time, even when we're not actively seeking such a conversation?

Well, here's the news: Both statements are true.

Oh, and yes, there *is* a God. That's also true.



Now the Higher Power might not be what you think it is, if you think it exists at all. You can refer to it in any way that you wish: He, She, Life, Source, Pure Energy, The Primal Essence, The Universe, etc. But God is real, alright. And two-way communication with this very real God can change your life.

“But wait a minute,” you might say, insisting on an answer to the earlier question. “I really need to know. Why would this ‘God’ that you say exists suddenly communicate with me, if I did not seek such a conversation?”

The answer is that you *did*. You might not know or remember that you did or realize how you did—but you did.

*Nothing* comes to you unless you draw it to you in some way. Welcome events, unwelcome events, anticipated events, totally unexpected events... all of life’s occurrences, experiences, conditions, circumstances, situations, incidents, and happenings are things that you have drawn to yourself. The only question is whether you’re doing it consciously or unconsciously, actively or passively, intentionally or unintentionally, purposefully or accidentally.

In the present instance, you might have drawn this communication from God unconsciously or passively, but I assure you that it was an energy within you that magnetized the book you are now reading and delivered it to you—whether you believe that or not.

“Okay,” you might say. “Let’s assume that’s possible. But the opening sentence of this book says *God is talking with me*. I might have found an interest in this book but calling it a direct communication from God is another thing entirely. Did you decide that your first book was a conversation with God just because you *said* that it was?”

No.

Fair question, but the answer is no. I had other, far more compelling, concrete, credible, and convincing reasons to decide that my experience was a direct communication with the Divine. And you might feel the same way about this book after you’ve finished reading it.

Now, for the record, I'm not saying that every word, every sentence, every passage on these pages is coming directly from the highest power in the universe. But I am saying that this book arriving in your life at this exact moment, and the main message it is designed to bring you, *is* a communication from God. It has come to you through what my wonderful friend Dr. Elisabeth Kübler-Ross, a psychiatrist and author for whom I once worked as a personal assistant, used to call "Divine intervention."

This brings us to the question of exactly how God interacts with us. It is my understanding and my experience that God communicates not just with words, but also—and sometimes only—with actions, events, visions, images, fragrances, sounds, ideas, your feelings, your experience, and an endless list of other phenomena in the physical world.

Did you ever have what you felt was a brilliant insight and wonder if it could possibly be true—then look up at the night sky and, at that exact moment, see a shooting star?

Do you think that just *happened*?

Have you ever come to a halt at a stop sign and started up again, only to feel an urgent impulse to lift your foot from the accelerator and slam on the brake pedal for no apparent reason—and then, as you did, watched a car whiz through the intersection in front of you at an insane speed, seemingly out of nowhere?

Do you think it was simply your *good fortune* that you were not involved in a terrible accident?

Have you ever been served a mouth-wateringly scrumptious soufflé as a guest at a friend's home and then, just before inserting your fork, thought to ask your host, "There's no shellfish in this, is there?"—only to find that the answer was, "Um, actually, yes."

Do you think it was *sheer luck* that you avoided being rushed to the hospital with anaphylactic shock because the soufflé contained an ingredient to which you are severely allergic?

I'd had each of those experiences, and I'm sure I'm not the only one who can tell tales of similar encounters with "fate."

Now, to bring us to the present moment: Do you think that this book popped into your awareness, or just dropped into your lap, out of the clear blue sky?

I'm going to suggest that you called it to you, that you *have* yearned at some level for a conversation about the Divine *with* the Divine, and that it is not a fluke, a coincidence, or an accident that a book with God's messages for you on every page "just happened" to show up in your life.

## GOD'S LAST CALL

“Turn right. Turn right! Turn right... right now!”

It was late spring, and we were cruising down the highway while visiting a friend on the north shore of Oahu in the Hawaiian Islands. Tim was behind the wheel, and I was riding shotgun when an unexpected surge of energy rose from my gut, filled my lungs, and flowed into my throat. The words flew out of my mouth with such force, my friend immediately pulled the car over.

Although he could not feel what I was feeling, Tim was a spiritual brother and knew me well enough to know that if I receive a mystical message, it was best to pay attention.

This totally unanticipated detour brought us to a parking lot adjacent to the ocean. Between us and the beach was a small patch of green grass that looked like a small cemetery. Perpendicular to us, about two blocks away, stood a grandiose white temple of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

With potent energy still churning in my gut, I hopped out of the car and scanned the perimeter, trying to figure out what might have called us to this spot. Thankfully, Tim trusted me enough to follow my lead.

As we traversed the green grass of the oceanside park, I felt drawn to a small gate that opened to the beach below. I clambered down the stairs, guided by an almost magnetic pull. I let my body pull me to the right. Tim trailed silently a few steps behind.

That was when I felt—and then a second later, saw—a brilliant light slightly above the horizon. It was not the sun; it was midday, and the sun was directly overhead. This powerful beam seemed to pulsate, emitting an energy as intense as the sun.

The force of the light was both irresistible and overwhelming. I felt strongly drawn toward it, even though it hurt to look at it. Hovering just above the ocean, its brilliant beauty drew me in, and yet, at the same time, its painful intensity repelled me. I could not look away from this extraordinary energy source!

Mesmerized, I kept moving along the beach at a slow but steady clip until my body gave out. I could not handle the magnitude of the energy. My legs buckled beneath me, and my knees fell to the sand. Tim rushed over and positioned his body as a haven to support me.

Leaning safely into Tim's arms, I had the security I needed to fully absorb this experience. My body shook as tears streamed down my face. The light had elicited a euphoria in me unlike anything I had ever experienced. Even as my body convulsed with sobs, I couldn't take my eyes off the blinding beam.

Every cell in my body was ignited by the energy. Something about the light felt like *home* to me. I felt I could be absorbed into that brilliance; in fact, I desperately wanted to be engulfed by the energy. I did not want this moment to end.

As I struggled to keep my eyes open to the beauty and ecstasy before me, I heard a deep voice, low and clear, deliver a powerful message: *You're going to want to be sober for this!*

This booming voice stunned me with its clarity and authority. I nodded my head to acknowledge that I had heard and understood. The voice said

nothing more and a few moments later, the light faded. My body jerked back to reality, as if the opposing team in a tug-of-war had released their end of the rope. I leaned back further against Tim, gripped with inexplicable sadness that the experience was over.

Tim and I rested on the sand simply breathing in and out together as he waited for me to speak. How could I explain what had just happened? How could I help my friend understand that I had been transported from this earthly plane into what felt like another dimension... and that God had served me up a plate of ecstasy wrapped in the most beautiful bright white light I had ever seen?

How could I make sense of—let alone share—the incomparable euphoria I had felt, and the relevance of the directive God had delivered in a booming, unfamiliar voice?

Luckily, I did not have to say a word. Tim just let me bask in the afterglow. He knew I had experienced something life-altering and that it would take time for my mortal self to process it. He helped me to my feet and supported me as we made our way back to the car. I felt both weary and energized. Perhaps this was how Moses felt after he experienced God's presence in the burning bush.

The intensity subsided, but the message remains with me always.

*You're going to want to be sober for this!*

Okay, then.

*Whatever 'this' might be, I thought to myself, I will do my best to show up stone-cold sober.*

Although I had occasionally abused alcohol in my younger days, I'd never had a serious drinking problem. Like many people who grow up in Irish Catholic families, I had a love-hate relationship with alcohol. I loved it during celebrations such as weddings and birthdays. I hated when the people I loved drank too much, because it made them disappear from the present moment and, hence, from themselves ... and from me.



But if alcohol was a hindrance to my chosen spiritual path of being 100 percent present to the full breadth and depth of waking up, I welcomed this Divine guidance telling me to face the future fully sober. I had witnessed too many people sleepwalking through life, and I did not want to be one of them.

With the inner work that I had done over the years, this Divine message felt both clear and personal. That was why I nodded my head in understanding when the Godly message came through for me. *You're going to want to be sober for this.*

It was not just about alcohol. It was about every way in which I was “asleep at the wheel” of my life, choosing to numb emotional pain through alcohol, food, binge-watching TV, or social media scrolling. I knew that this message was about emotional sobriety, a reminder that these vices might sedate my pain temporarily, but they also made me feel disconnected—from God, my higher self, my truest essence, and my home.

The powerful message I received on the beach in Hawaii has never left me. Nor has the memory of how it was delivered.

Would I ever have the courage to speak of it? Would I someday write about it? Perhaps “coming out of the closet” about this mystical experience would be the next step in my own awakening.

Perhaps this message was meant to be shared with the world.

# STRIKE WHILE THE IRON IS HOT



Experiencing a direct communication from the Divine can have a profound effect on any individual. What is the most beneficial way to respond, if and when we feel that we've had such an experience?

First, it's important to know is that there is no requirement around this. There is nothing that God needs you to do, expects you to do, or demands that you do. So gently step away from any worry about how God might react to how you react.

The second thing is, it's important to know is that it is not unusual to be stunned by your experience. The energetic encounter—especially the first one, if you eventually have a two-way conversation—may well produce emotions of awe, wonder, and even disbelief.

I chose not to shrug off the message I'd been given, and I'm going to offer this advice to you: After you have used your discernment to decide which thoughts, concepts, and ideas really are coming directly from God, give yourself permission to act on them. Do something about them *now*, instead of putting them on a mental pile for *later*.

## STEP INTO ACTION

When I was a child, there used to be a saying: “Strike while the iron is hot.”

To forge something from steel, you must pound the metal into the desired form while it is white hot, when it is pliable enough to turn into anything you want.

When you have a conversation with God, something wants to be forged from solid matter. So strike while the iron is hot. *Do it. Act on it. Step into it*, not away from it.

And do it now, not tomorrow. Not when you have more time, more money, or *whatever it is* you think you don't have enough of right now.

Make it your intention to at least begin. Perhaps it is true that you don't have a particular item, or a particular aspect, perfectly in place. But make it your intention to *begin*. And then... make it your intention to *complete*.

Remember that *life proceeds out of your intentions for it*. Completion is one indication of enlightenment. Notice how much lighter you feel when you complete *anything*.

In the book titled *The Only Thing That Matters*, I offered the observation that 98 percent of the world's people are spending 98 percent of their time on things that don't matter. Your life, it says, has to do with how you seek to reach *completion* on the journey of the soul.

Can this be true? Can it be that our time on Earth was never intended to be focused mainly on our physical experience, but on our *metaphysical* experience?

It can be true, and it is.

And...here's the best part: Going where your soul seeks to go, experiencing what your soul seeks to experience, and expressing what your soul seeks to express, does not mean denying yourself “the good life.” In fact, letting your soul guide you will go far toward *ensuring* you find the good life.

Completion of the soul's agenda does not require that you forego, shun, or renounce what your body and your mind enjoy. It is not about giving up one aspect of life for another, in a sort of unending version of Lent.

If you pay attention to your soul's agenda and to what it invites you to do, the rest of life will take care of itself. It will take *care* of itself *by* itself. Or, to paraphrase a far more eloquent statement: Don't go around asking, "*What are we to eat? What are we to drink? Wherewithal shall we clothe ourselves?*" *Seek ye first the Kingdom of Heaven, and all these things will be added unto you.*

The "Kingdom of Heaven" and "completion of the sacred journey" refer to the same thing. When you experience the second, you experience the first. The problem with both phrases is that no one has lately (if ever) explained how to seek the Kingdom of Heaven.

The Kingdom of Heaven is, of course, not merely a physical location. It is the state of being *complete*. Done. Finished. Over with the search for self. Through with looking for peace, answers, and reasons. And so, it is perfect that the two phrases are used here interchangeably.

It is literally "heaven" for humans to find themselves in a state in which they are clear that there is nothing left they need to be, do, or have, to experience inner peace, unconditional love, and the gentle bliss of sweet (as opposed to angry, aloof, or "holier-than-thou") detachment. All the inner peace that is, and all that one could ever desire, is fully present and can be experienced *right here, right now*. One merely needs to stop resisting what the current moment is presenting and remember that "What you resist, persists, and what you look at ceases to have its illusory form."

Once we see the illusion as what it is and realize that nothing and no one can touch us in any way that can hurt, injure, anger, frustrate, disappoint, or damage our souls—we are *complete*.

The soul's agenda is to bring you to this very state, so that you may recreate yourself anew in each *golden moment of now* and become the next

grandest version of the greatest vision ever you held about *who you are*. In this way, you can overcome exterior events or circumstances impacting the body or the mind.

Borrowing again from *The Only Thing That Matters*, being *complete* creates the space for that aspect of life that is called “you” to express, experience, reflect, demonstrate, and personify that aspect of life that is called Divinity.

So, intend to *begin*—and intend to *complete*—the next step in the process of your own evolution. Don’t wonder about what it is you should do in the next moment of your life. Don’t worry about what, in specific terms, your next step should be, or the exact way to deal with your current dilemma. Instead, say this prayer:

*Thank you, God, for helping me  
to understand that this problem  
has already been solved for me.*

Ask God whatever you wish to ask. Then listen, watch, and wait. Listen for the answer.

## TRY IT RIGHT NOW

Let’s have some joy and engage this process right now. I’m going to invite you to formulate any question that you would like to ask God in this moment.

Take out a piece of paper and a pen and write that question down. Make it a question that’s important to you—not something frivolous, like who’s going to win the Kentucky Derby or what’s the lucky lottery number. Write down something that matters to your heart and your soul.

Go ahead. Take a moment right now and write that down.

Good.



Now I want you to know that this question *will* be answered. It will be answered instantly. Indeed, it has been written: “Even before you ask, I will have answered.”

Yet you might not hear the answer in this very moment. You may not be aware of it “right now.” This is important to understand before you engage the *Conversations with God* process.

There is no right or wrong way to experience this. If you do not instantly know the answer that God is giving you, do not make yourself or the process “wrong.” Go into it without expectation. Not everyone becomes aware of their conversation with God in the same way.

Let that be okay. Otherwise, you’ll run the risk of wanting too much for it to happen or *needing* too much for it to occur right now, in one particular way. Keep in mind the very act of wanting a thing pushes it away from you. This is because your urgent expression of *wanting* says to the universe that *you do not now have it*. And this is the reality you will experience because whatever you declare with energy and consistency will receive only one answer from God: Yes.

Remember that.

God only says “yes.”

So if you declare, “I want more *money* in my life!” God will say, “Yes, that’s true. You do.” And if you say, “Doggone it, I want my perfect *partner*,” God will say, “Yes, that’s true. You do.” And then you’ll wonder, “What’s wrong with me that I never get what I want?” because you don’t understand the laws of metaphysics. You don’t understand that as you speak it, so will it be done unto you—especially if you speak it with vehemence, with power, with high energy, and with consistency.

So stay out of this trap. Give yourself time. Have patience with yourself and with the process. When you deliberately ask a question of God, you ultimately will become aware of the answer. This will likely happen sooner if

you stop fearfully looking for it or demanding it with frustration and just let it “come to you.”

Ask, and you will be answered. Knock, and it will be opened unto you. So let yourself receive the answer in the fullness of time. Let it all be okay.
